



Remote Learning Home/School Agreement

We have prepared this home/school agreement to ensure all of our pupils receive access to remote teaching and learning.

As a school, we will provide:

- An online platform to deliver teaching and learning – Seesaw
- A weekly timetable of activities will be sent out via email and uploaded onto Seesaw by Friday evening, ready for the following week.
- Individual daily lessons will be scheduled to appear on Seesaw by 9.00am that day
- High quality and meaningful daily English and Maths lessons, using <https://www.thenational.academy/> as our main platform
- High quality and meaningful daily topic tasks
- Weekly Physical Education challenges
- Feedback within 48 hours
- A Reward System - House Points
- A forum for you to ask teachers and TAs for support – via Seesaw or email

There is an expectation that all pupils will engage with and complete all work set on Seesaw daily. To this end, we require the following from parents/carers

- To be informed by you in the morning if for some reason your child is going to be unable to participate that day due to illness or some other such circumstance, similar to an absence notification.
- Provide opportunities for your child/children to access Seesaw on a daily basis
- Work to be uploaded to Seesaw by 10pm of that day (but as early as possible please to help our teachers).
- Communicate with your child's class teacher if you are having any difficulties

We expect our pupils to:

- Complete the tasks asked of them, with as much effort as would be applied in school – we know how hard you can work and how amazing you are!
- Complete daily reading (KS1 – 10 minutes to/with an adult. LKS2 – 10 minutes independently. UKS2 – 20 minutes independently)

If we do not hear from you, you will receive an email from us requesting a response, and following on from that a phone call.

All children who attend our Key Worker Provision will be following the same program of study as those accessing remotely. The children will be expected to engage with the remote learning set on the days they do not attend.

The learning plans set by our teachers are incremental, the units building on one another, therefore it is vital that they are done in order and none missed. The Government expectation is that the learning provided closely matches our school curriculum and as such will be chosen carefully by teachers to fit in with our long term school planning and will be suitable to be done in a home setting.

Our daily schedule will contain the following:

- A Mental Well-being welcome to the day
- A Literacy lesson (incorporating Spag)

- A Maths lesson
- A topic activity with guided instructions
- A pre-recorded Phonics video, differentiated to suit the learning of each child (KS1)
- A pre-recorded Times Tables video (LKS2)
- A pre-recorded Arithmetic video (UKS2)

In addition to the above, KS2 classes will hold a live, weekly, Guided Reading session. Our KS1 class will hold a live, weekly Storytime session. This done via MS Teams. You will receive an invite to access these prior to the session. Sessions last approx. 30 minutes and are scheduled as follows;

Diamonds – Monday 9:15am

Emeralds – Tuesday 9:15am

Rubies - Wednesday 9:15am

We promise to put the well-being of our children, their families and staff at the forefront of everything we deliver in these tricky times. We will continue to adapt our plans as appropriate to ensure the inclusive learning of all our children.

We do understand that for many of you, home learning will be a significant challenge – juggling children of different ages, jobs, device limitations and possible illness – however it is vital that we continue to provide learning opportunities to ensure that our children reach their full potential, now and in the future. We are here to help support you and your children.
