

## School Dress Code

## **PE**

The kit should consist of navy blue shorts, a blue T-shirt, a pair of trainers or plimsolls are required when PE or games are held outside. All items must be labelled and the kit needs to be in a named drawstring bag. Jogging bottoms, a sweatshirt and gloves may be needed in the winter months for certain outdoor activities.

Keeping safety in mind, the children are strongly discouraged from wearing all jewellery to school including earrings, which can be dangerous when they are playing or doing PE. Only stud earrings should be worn. If children cannot remove earrings themselves for PE please supply plasters or suitable covering material. Make-up, nail varnish and tattoos should not be worn to school at any time and long hair should always be tied up.

**All clothing must be labelled.**
